- ➤ Prevention of elloitation of migrants in the work lace and society in general

- Dealing with concerns of host society
 - Protection for national workforce in the event of increases in labour migration
 - **►** Education of host □o□ulation

 - ➤ Identifying labour shortages in □ O□ H skilled e g health □rofessionals, I□□and lower-skilled e g domestic work household em□loyment, agriculture, construction□sectors
- ➤ Ste□ 2□Designing the admission □olicy
 - Idmission of foreign nationals is essentially a matter for States in elercise of their sovereignty
 - ➤ Destination countries have to decide on the tyles of admission to sullort
 - **>** em□loyment-based immigration ☐ for settlement□
 - **>** tem□orary labour migration

- **Points systems** □usually with a view to settlement□
 - > eg □ ustralia, Canada, □ □ □
- **>** □ uotas or ceilings
 - in consultation with other □ertinent stakeholders □regional authorities, em□loyers and trade unions□
 - > eg numerical □uotas □taly, S□ain□
- **►** Labour market □resident worker tests
- **>** Occu□ational shortages lists
 - > facilitate admission of migrant workers into certain sectors
 - > no labour market test is required
