Traffic Safety was the theme of discussion in the one-hour live talk show aired on 2nd November 2015 on the First Channel of Radio Television Montenegro (RTCG). This was the ninth on the series of twenty shows named "Reaching the Trust Together", which is supported by the OSCE Mission to Montenegro.

Moderated by Andrijana Kadija, participants in the debate included Ilija Janjušević from Police Directorate; Milorad Popović, judge at the Misdemeanour Court; Savo Parača from Road Directorate; Slododan Vlačić from the Driving School "Vlačić" and Aleksandar Dedović, Executive Director of the NGO Alpha Center.

Panellists discussed key issues related to traffic safety, legislative framework, institutional competences and responsibilities as well as main causes of road accidents and importance of preventive mechanisms. Participants agreed that proper and timely education is of vital importance as well as awareness raining campaign which would target all traffic participants.

Damir Okanović, from Serbian Committee for Traffic Safety, also gave his contribution to the discussion by emphasising the importance of multi-sectoral approach in order to properly address traffic safety issues.

The main aim of the talk shows is to serve as a platform for dialogue and to engage various segments of society in Montenegro which will serve in the enhancement of confidence, trust, and cooperation between the public, institutions, media, and civil society.
