Mr. Chairperson,

We thank our Turkmen friends for their excellent organization of the recent meeting of the Council of the Heads of State of the Commonwealth of Independent States (CIS), which focused on the further development of co-operation within the Commonwealth. Discussions were also held on some of the most pressing international issues.
