On the Ceasefire Violations on the Armenia – Azerbaijan Border

As delivered by Acting Deputy Chief of Mission Tracey Newell to the Permanent Council, Vienna February 15, 2024

The United States is alarmed by the reports of ceasefire violations along the Armenia-Azerbaijan border and deeply regrets the loss of life and injuries sustained in the shooting. Dialogue and a peaceful settlement process are the only ways to resolve disputes. The use of force is not acceptable.

We urge Azerbaijan and Armenia to sustain your significant progress toward a durable peace treaty that respects each other's sovereignty, territorial integrity, and jurisdiction. The United States encourages continued engagement among all parties to maintain momentum, build on past negotiations, and conclude a dignified and durable peace agreement.
