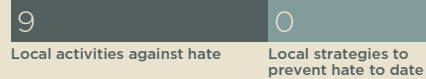

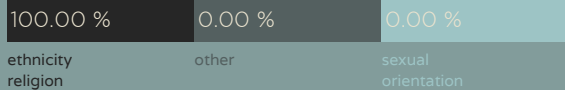

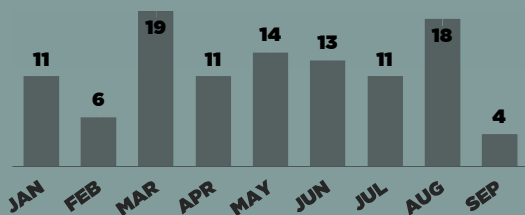

### Highlighted

In September 2016, the Coalitions against Hate in Doboj, Foča, Gradačac, Novo Sarajevo, Prijedor, Višegrad and Vitez monitored adherence to the signed pre-election campaign Codes of Ethical Conduct for political parties and candidates relating to hate speech, discriminatory rhetoric and incitement to intolerance. All of the involved Coalitions reported surprisingly calm political campaigns in the monitored areas.

The Hate Monitor provides an update on all hate-motivated incidents and responses known to the OSCE Mission to BiH at the time of publishing the report each month.
