DECISION No. 1119 RECOMMENDATION TO EXTEND THE APPOINTMENT OF THE OSCE SECRETARY GENERAL

The Permanent Council,

Recalling the decision of the Third Meeting of the CSCE Ministerial Council in Stockholm in 1992 to establish the post of Secretary General, Ministerial Council Decision No. 15/04 of 7 December 2004 on the role of the OSCE Secretary General and Ministerial Council Decision No. 3/08 of 22 October 2008 on the periods of service of the OSCE Secretary General,

Further recalling Ministerial Council Decision No. 2/11 of 20 June 2011 on the appointment of Mr. Lamberto Zannier as Secretary General of the OSCE and considering that his first term of office expires on 30 June 2014,

- 1. Requests the Chairperson of the Permanent Council to transmit to the Chairperson-in-Office the draft Ministerial Council decision on the extension of appointment of the OSCE Secretary General, as contained in document MC.DD/1/14 of 1 April 2014;
- 2. Recommends that the Ministerial Council adopt that decision through a silence procedure with the period of silence expiring on 14 May 2014, at 5 p.m. CET.

The Permanent Council,

Considering that, according to Ministerial Council Decision No. 1/11, the term of office of the current Director of the Office for Democratic Institutions and Human Rights (ODIHR), Mr. Janez Lenarčič, will expire on 30 June 2014,

- 1. Requests the Chairperson of the Permanent Council to transmit to the Chairperson-in-Office the draft decision of the Ministerial Council on the appointment of the Director of the ODIHR as contained in document MC.DD/2/14/Rev 1 of 23 April 2014;
- 2. Recommends that the Ministerial Council adopt that decision through a silence procedure with the period of silence expiring on 7 May 2014, at 12 noon CET.
