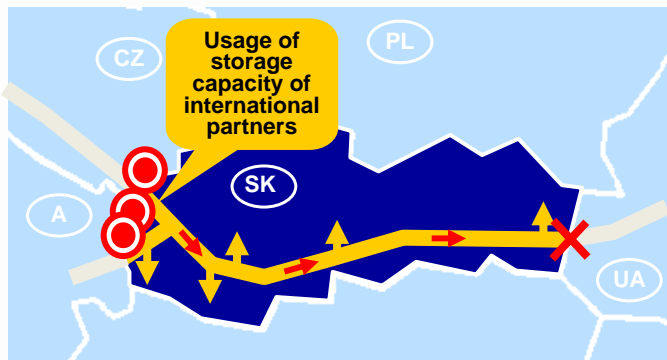

## Consequences: Do's !



- Learn from the „new“ history!

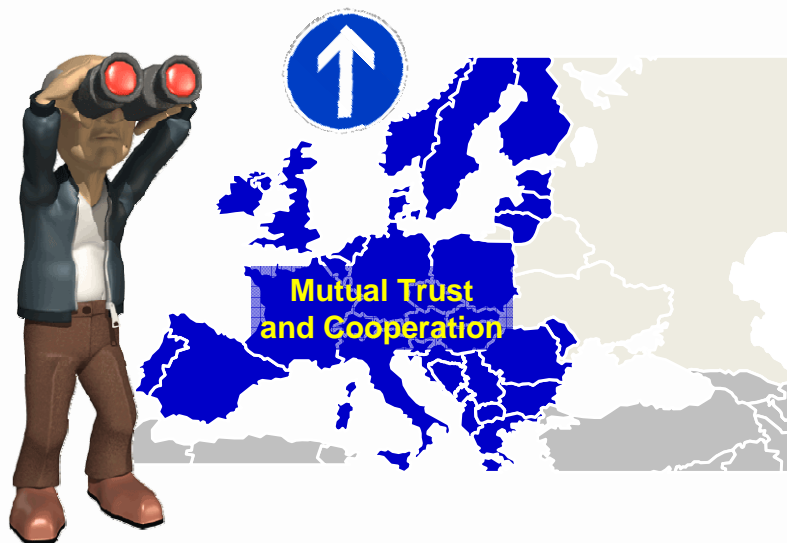
