Submit up to **three photographs** in High Definition, minimum image resolution of 1920 x 1080 pixels; or **a poem** in English or your mother tongue, as text, video recital or a song, together with your basic information.

Only materials on the topics of **human rights, non–discrimination and equality** will be considered.
No hate and/or offensive language is allowed.

The author of the best photograph will be awarded with an **EOS Digital Camera**. Best photographs will be showcased in an **exhibition** at the launching event on 10 December 2018 to mark the **International Human Rights Day**.

The author of the best poem will receive a **Notepad** as a prize and will work together with a consultant to prepare for a performance at the launching event.
