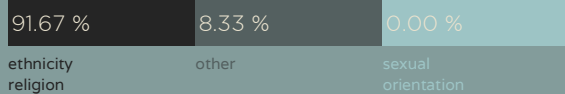

TYPES OF INCIDENTS

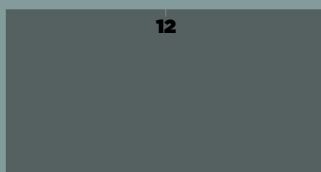


Incidents can consist of several acts.

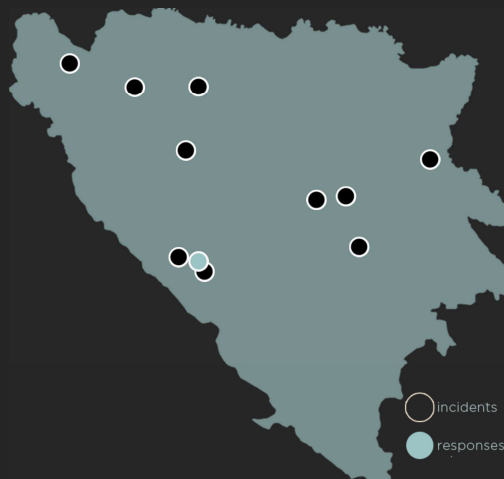
