## Key Recommendations for OSCE Summit in Kazakhstan, 2010

**Our key recommendations for the OSCE Summit in Kazakhstan, in Dec. 2010, based upon documentation of current discrimination of Christians in Europe, are:**

- **To Defend Freedom of Speech** - to include that Christians can teach Christian/ Biblical anthropology, faith and morality
- **To Defend Freedom of Conscience** - to include medical personnel, parents in the education of their children as well as Christian teachers and magistrates
- **To Recognize the Specific Dangers of Hate Speech and Anti-Discrimination legislation** - which often restricts freedom of expression, freedom of conscience, freedom of contract, and causes reverse discrimination & partiality
- **To Maintain Freedom of Religion, Conscience and Expression as a Key Mandate of OSCE/ODIHR** and the OSCE Chairperson-in-Office's Personal Representative on Combating Racism, Xenophobia and Discrimination, Mr. Mario Mauro, in **reiteration of the findings and conclusions of the OSCE/ODIHR Roundtable on Intolerance and Discrimination against Christians held in Vienna on March 4<sup>th</sup>, 2009**
