Trafficking in Human Beings was the theme of discussion in the one-hour live talk show aired on 5th October 2015 on the First Channel of Radio Television Montenegro (RTCG). This was the fifth on the series of twenty shows named "Reaching the Trust Together", which is supported by the OSCE Mission to Montenegro.

Moderated by Andrijana Kadija, participants in the debate included Zoran Ulama, Head of the Office for Fight Against Trafficking in Human Beings; Veljko Rutovic, Special Prosecutor; Igor Vučinić, Head of the Department for groups at risk, Ministry of Labour and Social Welfare and Aida Perović, NGO Women's Lobby.

During the discussion, the participants debated on key issues related to trafficking in human beings focusing on legislative framework, institutional capacities and challenges in this area. They agreed that joint work of all subjects is of great importance as well as awareness raising campaigns, capacity building and educational activities.

Marijana Berket from OSCE also provided her contribution and comments to the discussion by emphasising the importance of constant education in the area of THB and strong legislative basis. Amela Efendic, IFS-EMMAUS, BH and Dzenana Karup, journalist from BH, presented the situation in Bosnia and Herzegovina regarding trafficking in human beings and emphasised the importance of investigative journalism for this topics.

The main aim of the talk shows is to serve as a platform for dialogue and to engage various segments of society in Montenegro which will serve in the enhancement of confidence, trust, and cooperation between the public, institutions, media, and civil society.
