- Cooperation between East and West



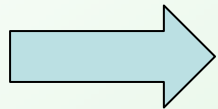
Conclusions

- Lack of law enforcement
- No understanding of effects and impact trafficking on children

What does not work?

1. Difficult to measure effects
2. Involvement law enforcement
3. Finding (ToT) trainers
