1st

I would like to address the following questions to the representatives of Kosovo and Germany
Serbian Roma who marry a Roma from Kosovo and decide to settle down in Kosovo do not have the right to have any kind of personal documents for five years which are necessary when applying for a job, or to be officially married, as to use social welfare services. How could the government of Kosovo solve the problem of full citizenship of these Roma?

2nd

I would address this question to the German government according to bilateral agreement between Germany and Serbia, Serbian citizens living in Germany are returned home.

As a consequence of the stages of the legislation, mixed families are often separated because they do not have the necessary official documents from Kosovo

3rd

It would also be essential to draw the attention of the government of Kosovo and OSCE mission of Roma in international organizations, governmental institutions, local governments dealing with projects for Roma and minorities. How many Roma are employed in such projects?
