The Permanent Council decides to request the Chairman of the Permanent Council to forward to the Chairman of the Ministerial Council drafts for the agenda and for the decisions foreseen under item 9 of the Ministerial Council agenda.

Interpretative statement under paragraph 79 (Chapter 6) of
the Final Recommendations of the Helsinki Consultations

By the delegation of Bulgaria:

“With reference to the decision just taken to forward to the Ministerial Council drafts for the decisions foreseen under agenda item 9, and to paragraph 20 of the draft Decision of the Ministerial Council on OSCE Action for Peace, Democracy and Stability in Bosnia and Herzegovina, the Delegation of Bulgaria to the OSCE states its understanding that the limitations on armaments, equipment and personnel established for Bulgaria under the CFE Treaty and the Concluding Act of the Negotiations on Personnel Strength of Conventional Armed Forces in Europe will not be subject to the negotiations foreseen under Article V of the Dayton Agreement.”

Interpretative statement under paragraph 79 (Chapter 6) of
the Final Recommendations of the Helsinki Consultations

By the delegation of the United States of America:

“Mr. Chairman, as we understand the Bulgarian statement with respect to paragraph 20 of the draft Decision of the Ministerial Council on OSCE Action for Peace, Democracy and Stability in Bosnia and Herzegovina, it is a statement of national intent or policy, but it is not the same as the last sentence of paragraph 20 on which all delegations agreed. The sentences simply do not mean the same thing.”
