“OSCE Summit 2010 – conclusions and follow-up”**

Mr. Chairman,

The delegation of Ukraine is grateful to the Kazakhstan Chairmanship for the outline of the Summit conclusions and follow-up.

We share the view that Astana Summit was a significant landmark for Organization that recognised the importance of an inclusive, comprehensive and indivisible security community from Vancouver to Vladivostok.

We believe that the dialogue that took place at the summit is of great importance for better understanding of challenges we jointly face and the areas of common action that need to be pursued.

The reaffirmation of commitments in the Astana Commemorative Declaration is a successful outcome of the Summit, which we consider as an important starting point for our future efforts to establish the OSCE Security Community.

Ukraine is ready in close consultations with incoming Chairmanships and all participating States to constructively contribute to our dialogue, seeking a new quality of OSCE activities and working out a forward-looking Action plan that would very clearly direct our future common work.

The delegation of Ukraine would like to take this opportunity to once again express its appreciation to the Kazakhstan Chairmanship for their efforts and dedicated work aimed at strengthening our Organization.
