THE HISTORY OF ALBANIAN WOMEN BEFORE THE WWII – A GENDER PERSPECTIVE

The untold stories of Albanian women

The Presence is launching the second open call for bringing information about the role and situation of women in Albania in the period before the WWII. This research intends to go beyond traditional roles of women in Albanian society and look into narratives on women in the public, political and social life.

Five young researchers will be supported to conduct research in the State Archive and to write short (5-7 pages) research papers in Albanian by 18 December 2018 evidencing challenges of women's societal, political and economic participation, and early champions of gender equality in Albania.

- A motivation letter (max. 1,500 characters in English or Albanian), outlining your motivation and expectations from the participation in this research work.
- Research proposal (max. 2,000 characters in English or Albanian), including research questions and table of contents).
- CV in English, including contacts of at least two referees (names of professors or supervisors).
