In 2018, the OSCE-led survey on the Well-being and Safety of Women was implemented in selected OSCE participating States in South-East Europe and Eastern Europe. It is based on the methodology used by the European Union Fundamental Rights Agency for their survey on violence against women in 28 EU member states.

The OSCE-led survey provides a unique and comparable insight into the prevalence and consequences of violence against women, into persistent harmful norms and attitudes as well as reasons why survivors do not report their experiences to responsible institutions.

The OSCE Gender Section would like to use this opportunity to present the main research findings to a broader international audience. Attendees will have the possibility to talk to or interview representatives of NGOs and governmental institutions from the regions covered by the survey as well as to representatives from UN agencies, which will make use of the research in their future work.

The project is supported by the European Union, UNFPA, UN Women and UNICEF as well as the governments of Austria, Finland, Germany, Italy, Norway, the United States of America and Sweden.
