**STATEMENT BY
THE DELEGATION OF SERBIA**

Mr. Chairperson,

Since my country has been mentioned, the delegation of the Republic of Serbia wishes to recall that any reference to Kosovo and Metohija in the work of the OSCE should remain fully status-neutral and in strict accordance with United Nations Security Council resolution 1244.

For Serbia, Kosovo and Metohija is the Autonomous Province of Kosovo and Metohija, and we therefore cannot accept language that prejudices its status or departs from the agreed international framework.

We underline the importance of consistent adherence to status-neutral terminology at the Conference and of full respect for the sovereignty and territorial integrity of the Republic of Serbia.

I request that this statement be attached to the journal of the Conference.
