OSCE School and Model OSCE Conference

20 – 27 July 2025

Tbilisi, Georgia

The OSCE Secretariat is organizing two events in Tbilisi for young people from Central Asia and the South Caucasus: an **OSCE School, followed by a Model OSCE Conference**. Through these two events, the OSCE wants to promote cross-regional exchanges and build professional skills of the next generation of peace practitioners.

- **The OSCE School, from 20 to 23 July 2025** will include a series of briefings and interactive workshops to learn about the comprehensive approach of the OSCE across the three dimensions of security, as well as open discussions with practitioners and OSCE officials.
- **The Model Conference, from 23 to 27 July 2025**, focuses on acquiring mediation and negotiations skills, through participation in a simulation exercise of one of the OSCE decision-making processes.

Participants of the OSCE School and Model conference will meet at a joint gathering on 23 July. The OSCE will cover all participation-related expenses, including travel to Georgia, accommodation and meals. All selected participants are expected to actively engage in pre- and post-event activities, such as **alumni events**. This project is supported by the U.S. Mission to the OSCE, the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of Finland and the Embassy of Switzerland in Georgia.
