Permanent Mission of the Republic of Bulgaria Statement under item 3 "Current Issues" of the Agenda of the 768th Meeting of the Permanent Council of the OSCE 9th July 2009

Madam Chairperson,

The Bulgarian Delegation would like to thank the distinguished US representative for his statement concerning the parliamentary elections in Bulgaria that took place on 5th July 2009.

Indeed, the International Election Observation Mission (OSCE/ ODIHR and PACE), evaluated these elections as "competitive and well-run, and generally in accordance with the international standards". The observers also concluded that "the elections provided voters a broad choice in a visible and active election campaign demonstrating respect for fundamental freedoms" and — as noted by the US Delegation — the results of the vote reflect the will of the people. The voter turn-out was 60.2 percent.

Regarding particularly changes in the Election Law it may be recalled that the public debate on this issue has started more than a year ago and is still ongoing. It can therefore be expected that any concerns raised, including any shortcomings, will be duly addressed.
