



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Experience from past 9 large floods in the Czech Republic




"Strategy for Protection against Floods in the Czech Republic" (agreed by the government in 2000) initiated:

- basic improvement of legislation
- improvement of communication new generations of cell phones
- available information (web sites) on PC for general public
- rescue teams (fire brigades) ready
- knowledge of flood areas (along over 80 % of the lengths of important water courses)
- introduced flood plans, flood committees and crisis committees
 - development of flood protection measures and subsidies for their realisation, namely in the localities of high flood risk



Introduction of the new legislation

- **❖** Act on Fire Rescue Brigades (No. 238/2000 Coll.)
- **❖** Act on Integrated Rescue System (No. 239/2000 Coll.)
- **❖** Act on Crisis Management (No. 240/2000 Coll.)
- **❖** Water Act (No. 254/2001 Coll. and amendments)
- Decree on Flood Areas (No. 236/2002 Coll.)
- Status of Central Flood Commission (Res. Government No. 806/2004 Coll.)





Conclusions and recommendations for a better transboundary flood risk management

- early forecasts essential
- mathematical models for meteorology as well as for outflows and flow rates development
- sharing of actual information internet, cell phones
- establishment of common bodies for flood protection strategy in transboundary watersheds
- use of unified ,,information systems" available to public
- continuous upgrade of communication links between responsible authorities
