Hosted by the Italian Cultural Institute in Vienna, on Monday 3 July at 7 p.m. a vernissage will introduce the topic of the Expert meeting. The event, carried out in the framework of the project AENEAS, with the support of the Italian 2017 OSCE Chairmanship of the Mediterranean Contact Group, addresses the topic of migrants' integration from the perspective of a local community in a depopulated and economically deprived area in the South of Italy.

The exhibition tells the story of the Calabrian village of Riace that, thanks to the impetus of its mayor Domenico Lucano, has been welcoming and integrating thousands of migrants. The combination of different factors allows the mutual adaptation of the hosting community and the newcomers. But most of all, this harmonious and complex two-way process, is the result of the responsible leadership of a Mayor that, in 2016, the magazine Fortune inserted in the list of the 50 most influential leaders in the world. Riace is an inspiration for the reception and integration of migrants and refugees.
